

## **U10 Belleville Bulls AA**Coach "Tryout" Information

## **Tryout information:**

- **On-ice Structure**: Players can expect a series of drills, small areas games, and scrimmages during tryouts.
- **Team Roster**: Fourteen skaters / two goalies (BMHA approved) will be selected.
- **Evaluation**: The coach will select players with feedback from independent evaluators who do not have any affiliation with the team.
- Evaluation Criteria:
  - Skaters: Fundamental hockey skills relevant to the U10 age group including, but not limited to, forward/backwards skating, puck-handing, passing, shooting, positioning, hockey sense, work ethic, and attitude will be evaluated.
  - Goaltenders: Fundamental goalie skills relevant to the U10 age group including, but not limited to, overall movement, basic saves, rebound control, positioning, skating, quickness, work ethic, and attitude will be evaluated.
- **Player Releases**: Releases will occur after the Monday, April 29 ice-time and each subsequent ice-time. All tryout attendees will receive 3 ice-times prior to releases.
  - Releases: Will be made electronically through the Belleville Minor Hockey website; an email should have been sent to you with your child's tryout number. Parents of players that have been released are welcome to reach out by email (<u>jamiesmith18@gmail.com</u>)
     24 hours after their final tryout and we can set-up a time to discuss.



## Season General Information:

- **Commitment**: Expect to have hockey team functions (practices, games, other development activities) 3-5 days per week for 1-1.5 hours per ice-session. Please ensure that you inform me early in tryout process if you do not intend on committing to the U10AA team if selected.
- **Cost**: Families can expect costs that range from \$1500-2000 over the course of a full season (early September end of March). This does not include the cost of equipment, hotels, travel, etc...
- League games: Season games are as far as Kingston (East), Ajax (West), and Peterborough (North).
- **Tournaments**: Three tournaments will be scheduled over the course of the season. All attempts will be made to select tournaments closer in proximity (ie. Kingston/Cobourg). There will likely be two closer tournaments and one tournament at a further distance (2-3 hours) that would require overnight stay in hotel.
- Development: As a coach, I will follow the long-term athlete development model. Athletes
  need opportunities to develop in the technical, tactical, physical, and mental components of the
  game. Every attempt will be made to provide these young athletes with age-appropriate
  development opportunities in each area.
